Discussed and agreed that PTFA will fund CPR training undertaken by the Swans Trust (minimum donation of £200) for year 6 class.

Further discussed and agreed PTFA will fund £225 towards the cost of 19-seater minibus to transport year 6 students to Salisbury Cathedral leavers event. Date TBC. PTFA may look into sourcing the transport.

PTFA agreed donation towards school trips of £13 per pupil, which is an increase of £1 from last year.
