Dear Parents/Carers

Ash visit to Launceston Farm – 30th June 2022

<u>Purpose</u>: Ash class have an amazing opportunity to visit Launceston Farm to enrich their learning for our new Project – Wriggle and Crawl. We will have the opportunity to investigate and learn about insects and their habitats. We will also learn about the importance of insects in farming and the wider environment.

<u>**Timings</u>**: We plan to leave school at 9.05am to get to the farm for a 9.30am start. Activities will end at 12.30pm and we will come back to school straight away for a late lunch.</u>

<u>Costs</u>: We are very fortunate that this trip is offered to us free of charge and we have applied for funding from the Fabulous Food and Farming Education Fund to cover the cost of the coach. Therefore, this trip incurs no costs to you.

Requirements:

Non-school uniform

Footwear – Please ensure that your child is wearing sensible sturdy footwear as we will be out in the fields. If it has been raining the previous day, they will need to bring wellies with them even if it is not raining on the day.

Clothing – As we will be out in the fields, it is important that the children wear long trousers (not shorts) even if it is warm. It is preferable for them to wear long sleeves too, however if it is really warm then short sleeves will be ok.

Weather permitting, we will be outside all morning therefore, if it is a sunny day please ensure that your child has had sun protection applied before they come to school. They will also need a sun hat. If the weather is wet, we will still aim to be outside as much as is possible, in this case, please ensure that your child has appropriate rainwear – rain jacket, waterproof trousers and wellies.

Could your child please bring a small snack for the morning.

<u>Lunch</u>: The children will require a packed lunch for this visit. Please also provide a full water bottle for them, even if you requesting a packed lunch from FoodLinks.
