In the Invasion project, your child will explore the effects of the Roman withdrawal and the chronology and geography of subsequent invasions.

They will study the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings in detail, examining their reasons for invading, their settlements and their everyday life. Your child will also look at monasteries and the Anglo-Saxon legacy.

They will consider how we know about life in this period. They will learn about Athelstan, an Anglo-Saxon king, and what happened after his death, before ending the project by learning about the Norman invasion of 1066.

To start the term, we will be experimenting with watercolour paint and thinking about colour theory and colour mixing

They will also be learning about the human digestive system and teeth, linking this to the DT project Food, Glorious Food.
