Driver Area: Understanding the World

- We will learn about the environments that we share with others, including our homes, school and places in the local community.
- We will learn about structures and materials. Children will have opportunity to work in groups to create collaborative structures.

Phonics, Drawing Club and Talk for Writing

Phonics: We will be learning a new sound each day.

Talk for Writing: Our focus novel for Autumn 1 will be Where the Wild Things are.

Communication & Language
