Maths

During maths this week, we have continued to practice our counting in 2's, 5's and our 10's. We have practiced by singing songs! We used our knowledge to create equal groups of numbers. We discussed what we mean by 'equal'.

English

This week we consolidated our knowledge of nouns and adjectives. We used this knowledge to create noun phrases to plan for our acrostic poem writing.

Art

We recreated art work from the artist 'James Rizzi' this week. We discussed what we enjoyed about his work. We used his ideas to create faces on our skyscraper buildings.

History

To start our 'School Days' topic, we had a tour of the school and Mrs Corbett told us what the school used to be like. We ended the lesson with writing questions that we would like to find out during our next few lessons.

Science

In our 'Animal Parts' scheme of work we focused this week on labelling body parts. We learnt more about these different groups of animals; mammals, amphibians, birds, invertebrates and reptiles and compared how body parts differ between species of animals. We started by labelling the parts of the human body collectively before having a go at labelling the body parts of a chosen animal.

In our Friday's PE lesson we will be starting to think and practise sporting activities for our upcoming Sports Day in May. These activities will include running, throwing and jumping.
