English

The children have enjoyed our topic learning about poems and have spent lots of time exploring adjectives. Reading

PSHE

In PSHE we have finished learning about our topic 'brushing our teeth'. We learnt about how to look after our teeth and why it is important to visit the dentist. Next week we will begin our new PSHE topic about 'bullying' - we will talk about the importance of recognising our feelings as well as the importance of thinking about others feelings. We will discuss what bullying behaviours can look like and how we can cope with these feelings and behaviours.
