Hello everyone,

It's hard to believe we're already approaching half term! The weeks have flown by, and the children have worked incredibly hard since the start of the year. They've settled well, shown real enthusiasm for their learning, and supported each other with kindness and teamwork.

In English, the children have been putting in lots of effort to include adjectives and similes into their own Autumn poems. We have now started our next topic based around 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs'. The children have loved hearing this story from the wolf's perspective and have begun writing in the style of a traditional tale.

In Maths, we have started our focus on addition and subtraction. The children have been using base ten and place value counters to aid them in spotting the patterns when adding 1's, 10's and 100's to a three digit number. They have quickly picked up on these patterns and are applying them to addition and subtraction problems.

In Science, the children have been learning about teeth and how to keep our teeth healthy. They are looking forward to our upcoming Science investigation when we will be investigating the effectiveness of toothpaste.

We have also begun our History topic 'Invasion'. To start this unit the children have learnt about life in Britain after the Roman withdrawal. They have been enjoying learning interesting facts about what life was like in Britain at the time and looking at a timeline of events of the different invasions that were to come!
