So far this term...

Acorns class have continued to settle into their new routines well and have been participating in some exciting events over the last couple of weeks. Some of the highlights of the last few weeks have been a visit from a Community First Responder as part of our Me and My Community topic and a lovely walk around our school grounds exploring the Autumn colours.

Maths

In Maths, Reception have been learning about simple patterns and even creating their own patterns using objects around the classroom. Our next topic in Maths will focus on the numbers 1,2 and 3.

Year 1 have been learning about Addition within 10. They have been using part whole models and writing their own addition sentences using plus and equal signs.

The Write Stuff

In Writing, we have been reading the story of 'Where the Wild Things Are'. The children have been coming up with adjectives to describe Max and the Wild things, talking about what makes a good friend and we are planning to have our own 'wild rumpus' like the Wild things in the story.

Topic

Last week we had a visit from a Community First Responder. He taught us all about what to do in an emergency including calling 999, showed us what medical kit Community First Responders take with them to emergencies and explained how they help people. We even had the chance to see the Community First Responder car and had a demonstration on how the emergency services use Razor chairs to help someone who has had a fall.
