Acorns have continued to have a fantastic first term! We have been very creative and have been doing lots of Art activities including leaf rubbing and leaf printing with the leaves we collected on our Autumn walk around the school grounds. Maths

In Reception, the children have been looking at the numbers 1,2 and 3 and learning how to count objects of this amount. We have also been looking at circles and triangles and describing the properties of these 2D shapes.

In Year 1, we have continued to look at addition within 10 by tackling more difficult addition word problems and missing number questions.

English

In our English lessons, we have continued to read 'Where the Wild Things Are' and we finally have our 'wild rumpus' in the playground, the children were able to come up with some lovely words to describe the way they moved during this.

In Reception this week we have been reading 'Room on the Broom' and drawing some dragons to describe. The Year 1 children have been working hard on their handwriting practice this week.

Topic

In our topic lessons we have been looking at our baby photos and played a game of 'Guess who' using our photos, we discussed the differences in our faces and bodies from when we were babies to now. We will be talking about our families in our upcoming lessons and having a go at drawing and describing our own families.
