### Maths

In **Reception**, the children have learning about 2D shapes naming their features such as number of edges etc.

In **Year 1**, the children have been continuing to focus on the numbers 1 – 20, their composition, one more and one less and number formation.

### English

As a class we have been sharing the stories *How to Count to One* and *Dear Santa*. **Reception** have been imagining vile restaurants, high tech roller skates and Santa's workshop. **Year 1** have been writing questions, sentences with precise verbs and using adjectives to describe.

### Topic

Our topic this term, *Once Upon a Time*, has been using traditional tales as inspiration for science-based learning. This has given us an introduction to materials and their uses thinking about how to keep the three little pigs dry and explaining which the best material is to make a comfortable bed for the princess and her pea.
