So far this term...

Welcome back to school for the second half of our spring term! This half term we're learning all about what happened in the prehistoric era, why the cross is important to Christians and the Easter Story.

Maths

In Maths, Reception have been learning about how to make ten including number bonds, doubles and even and odd numbers.

After this, we will look at 3D shapes.

Year 1 have been learning about place value to 50 including estimating on a number line, counting in tens and 1 more or 1 less. After this, we will look at length and height.

Literacy

In Literacy we are looking at non-fiction books including *If Sharks Disappeared* and *The Big Book of Bugs*. We will be using these to write facts and questions about the environment around us and the animals that we share the earth with.

Topic

Our topic this term is 'Dangerous Dinosaurs', your child will find out about prehistoric animals that lived on Earth. They will learn facts about dinosaurs and discover how big some of these giant creatures were. They will learn about the difference between carnivores and herbivores. They will also find out about the animals that lived after the dinosaurs and which modern-day animals have prehistoric relatives...
