Maths

In Maths, Reception have been starting to learn about adding and subtraction using the term 'how many now?'

Literacy

Topic

We started our new topic by going on a learning walk outdoors, where we observed how sunlight helps plants grow and noticed the bright, cheerful colours around us. During our walk, we carefully looked at different areas of the outdoor space and then worked together to create a map, showing where we found interesting features like flowers, shady spots, and sunny areas. This helped us understand how the environment changes and gave us a chance to connect our learning to the natural world around us.
